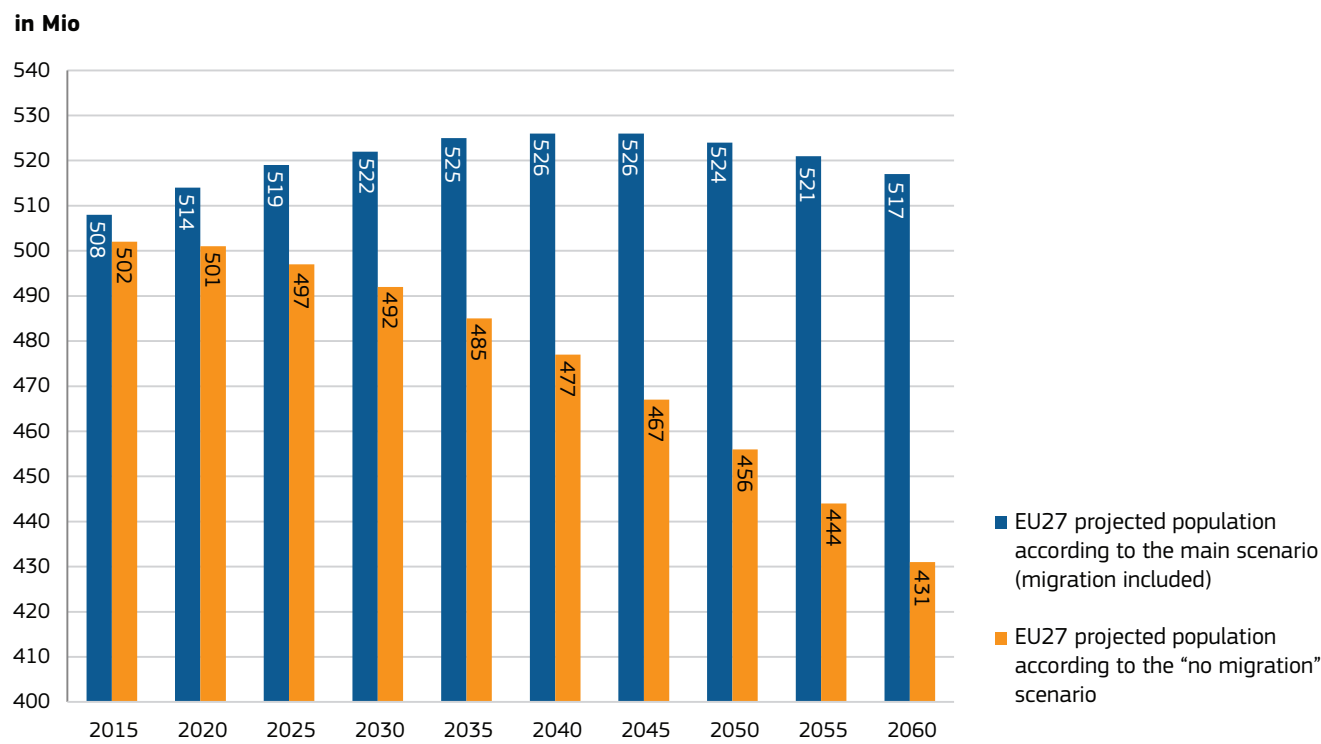

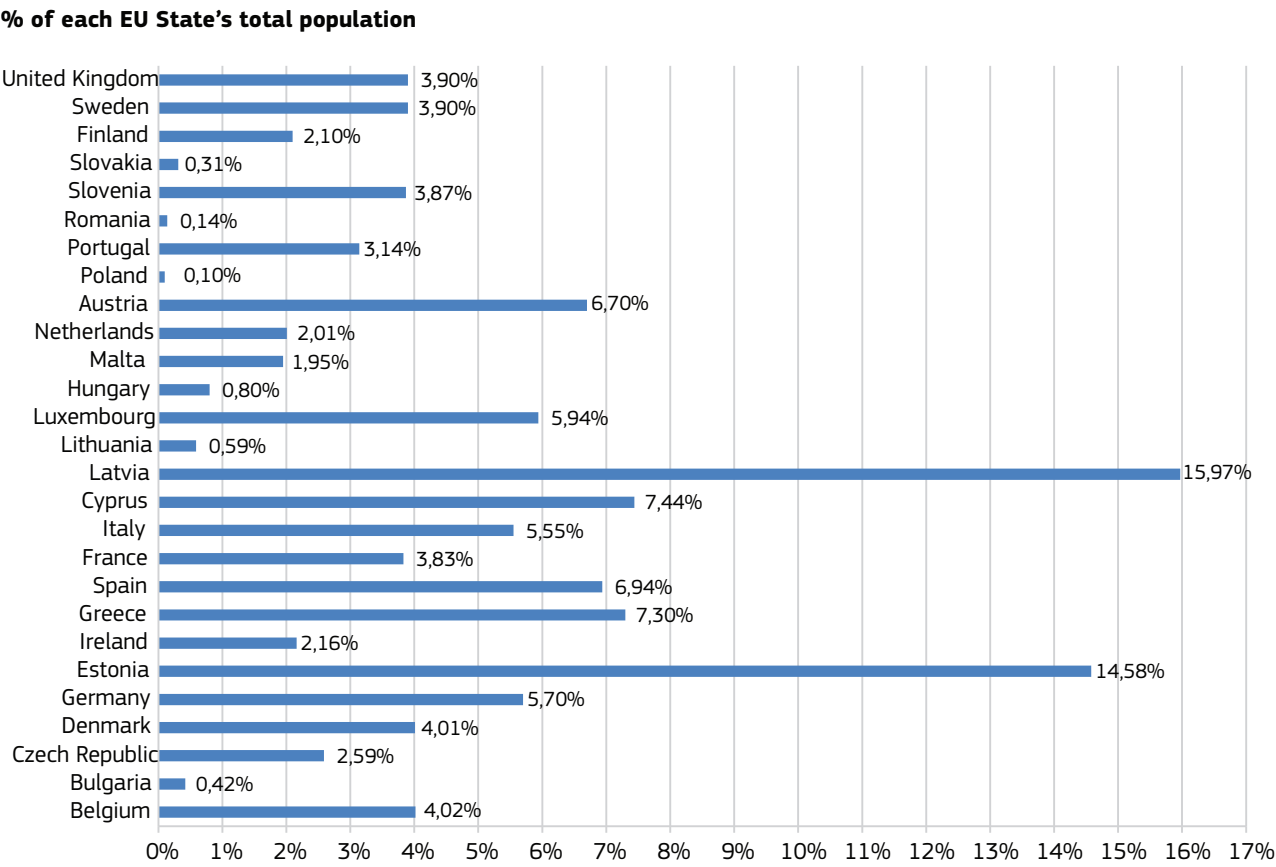

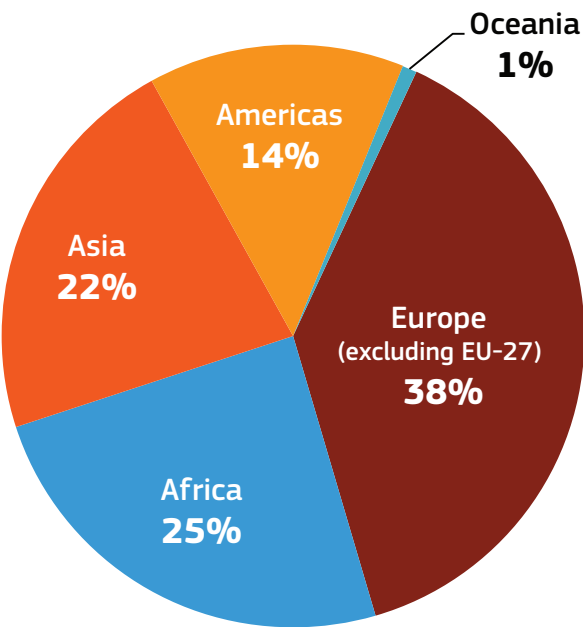


Non-EU nationals residing in the EU27 (1 January 2012)

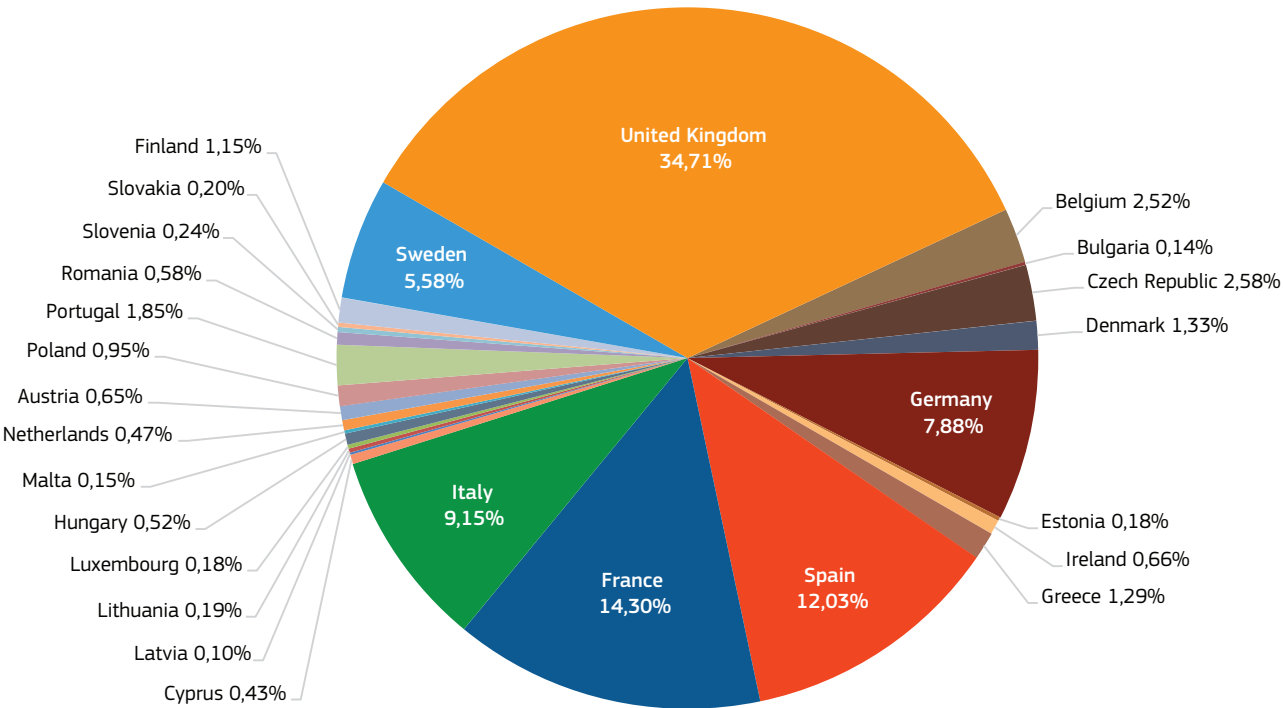

Origin by continent of non-EU nationals residing in the EU (2012)

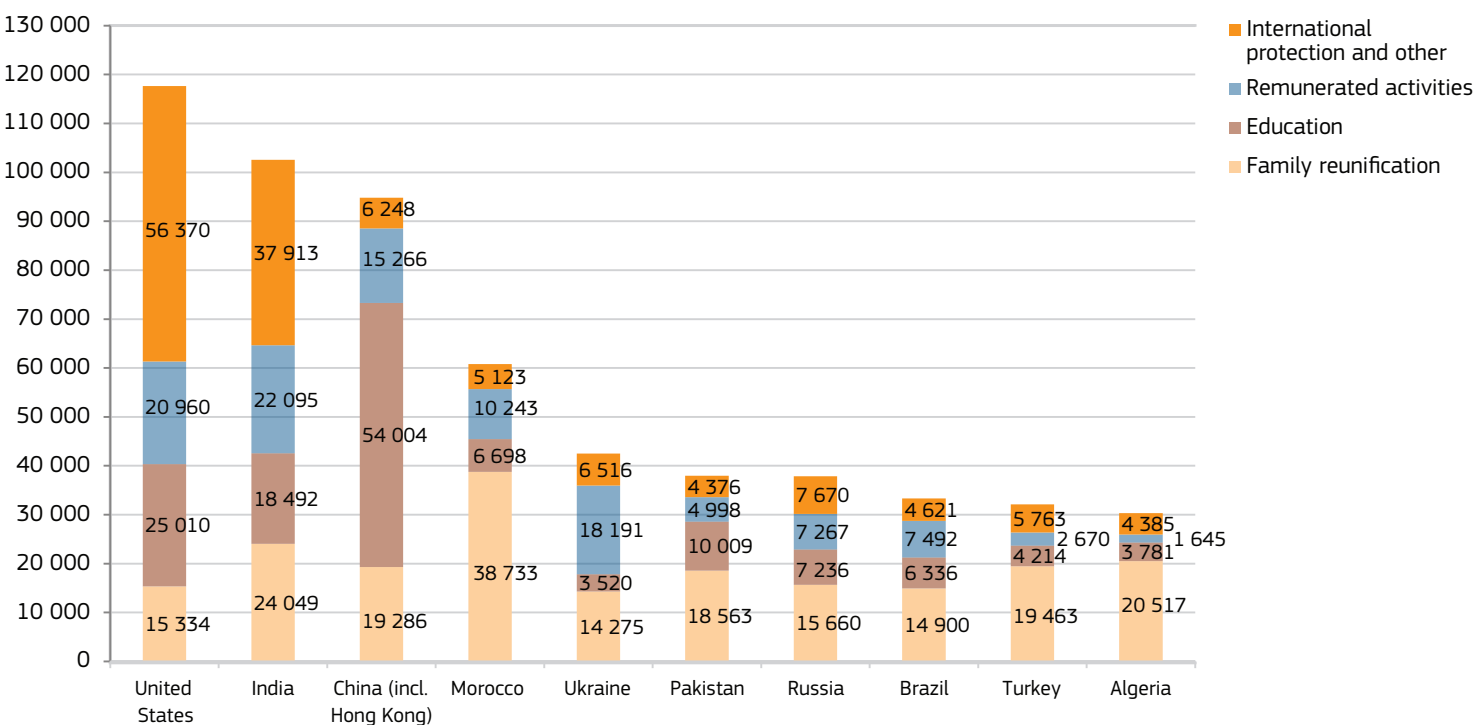


Share by EU State of first residence permits valid for 12 months or more issued to non-EU nationals (2012)

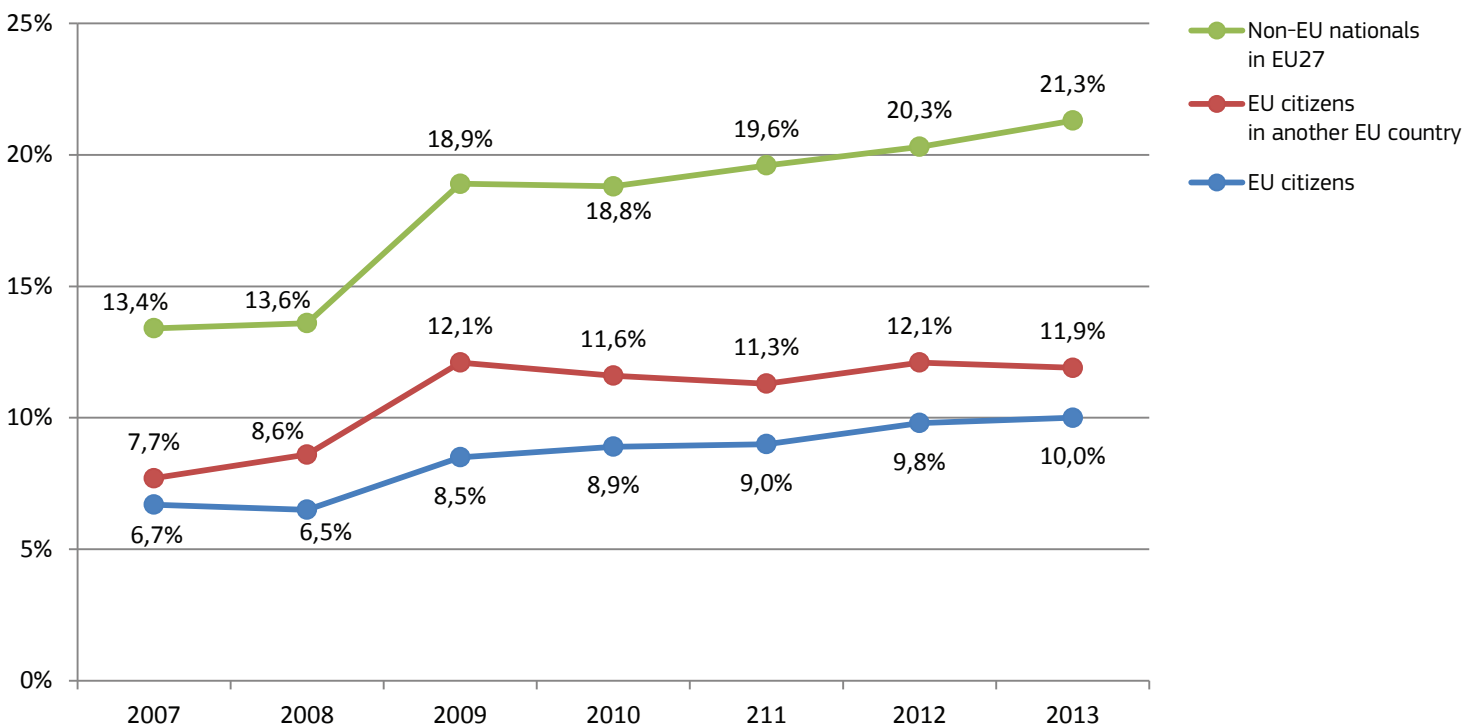

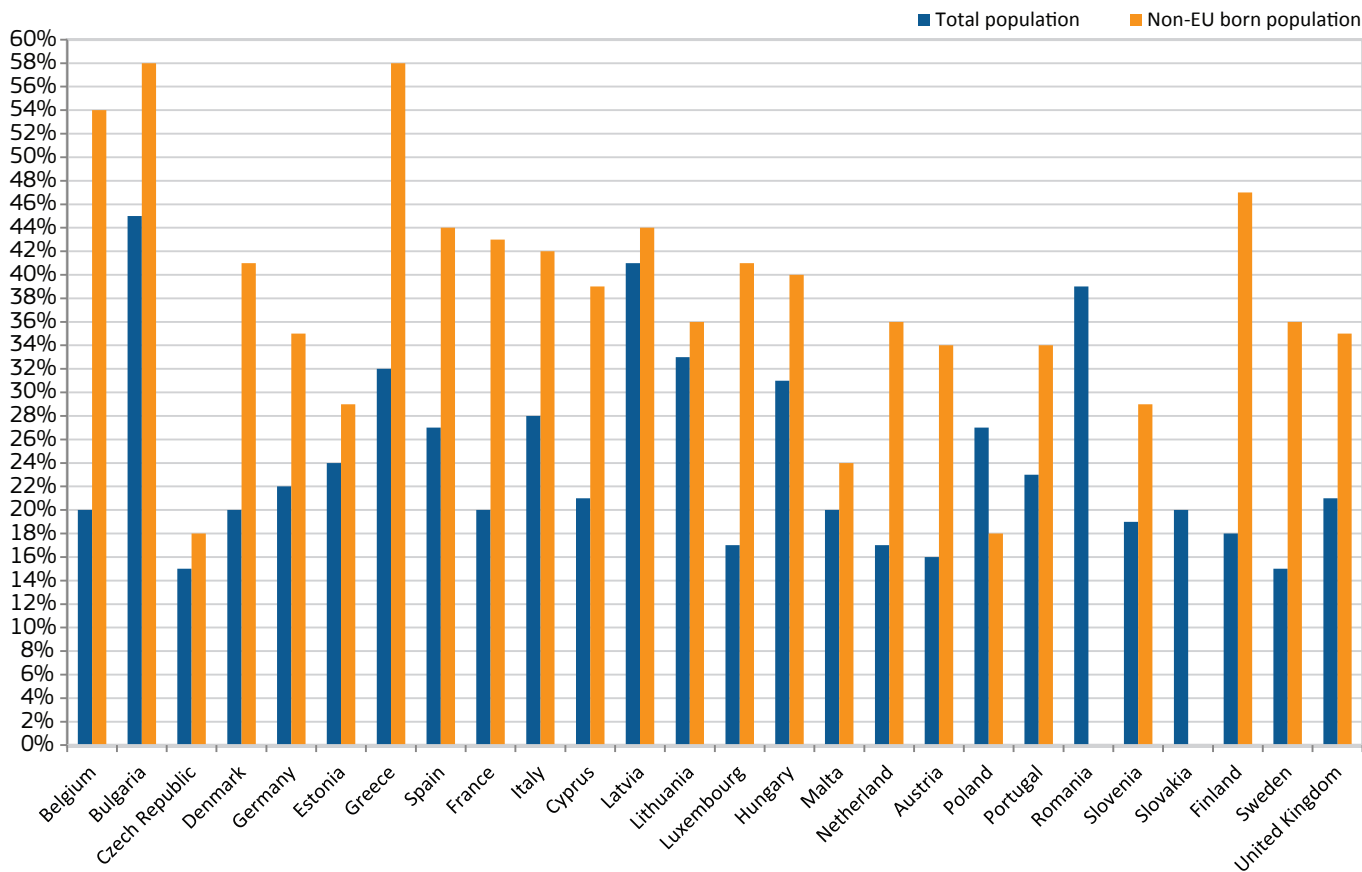


Unemployment rate in EU27 (in the third quarter of every year)

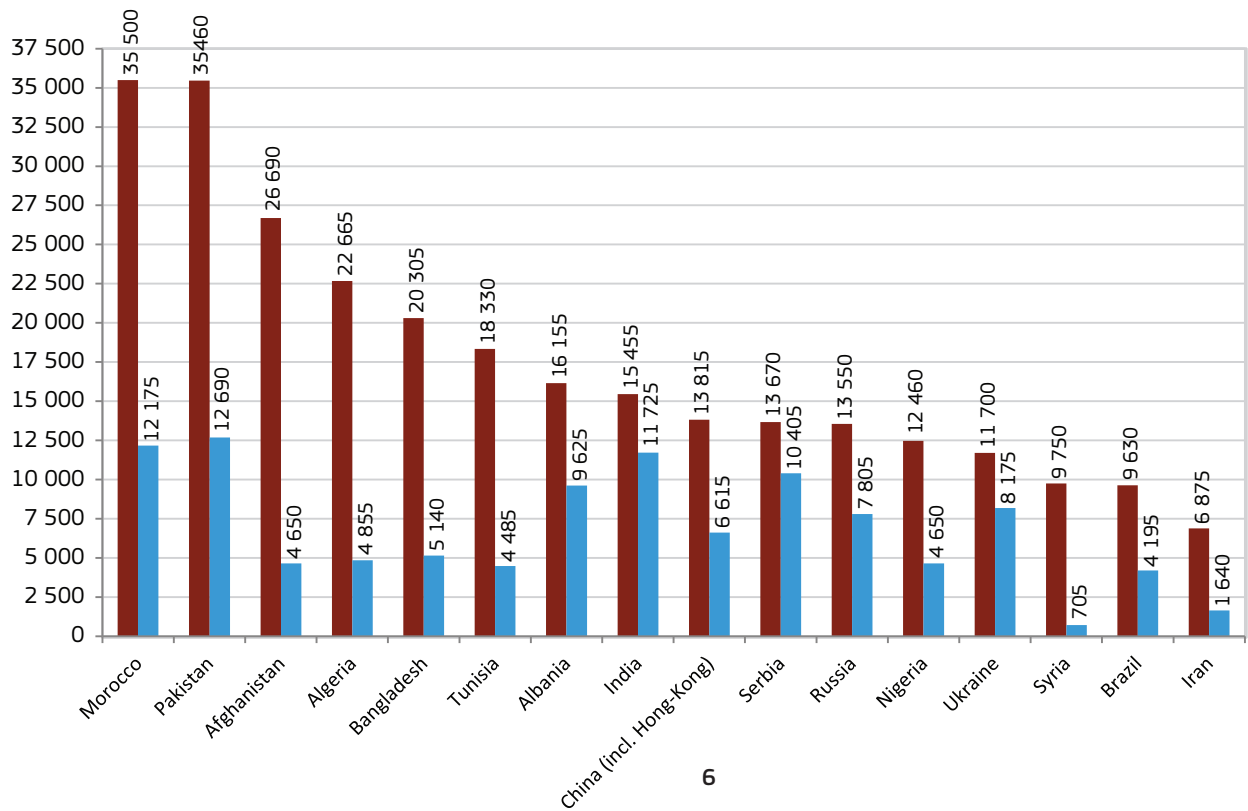
Share of total and non-EU born population (22-64 age group) at risk of poverty or social exclusion (2011)

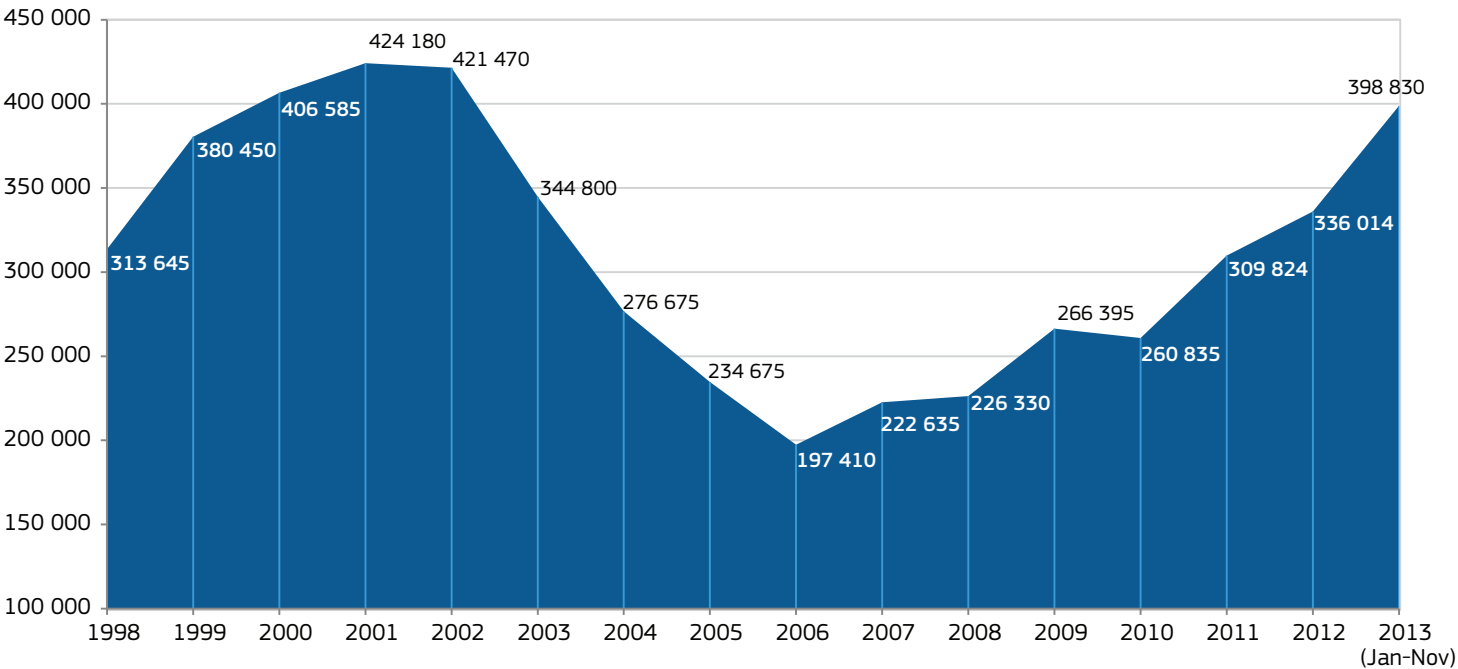
Comparison between return decisions and recorded returns by main countries of origin (2012)

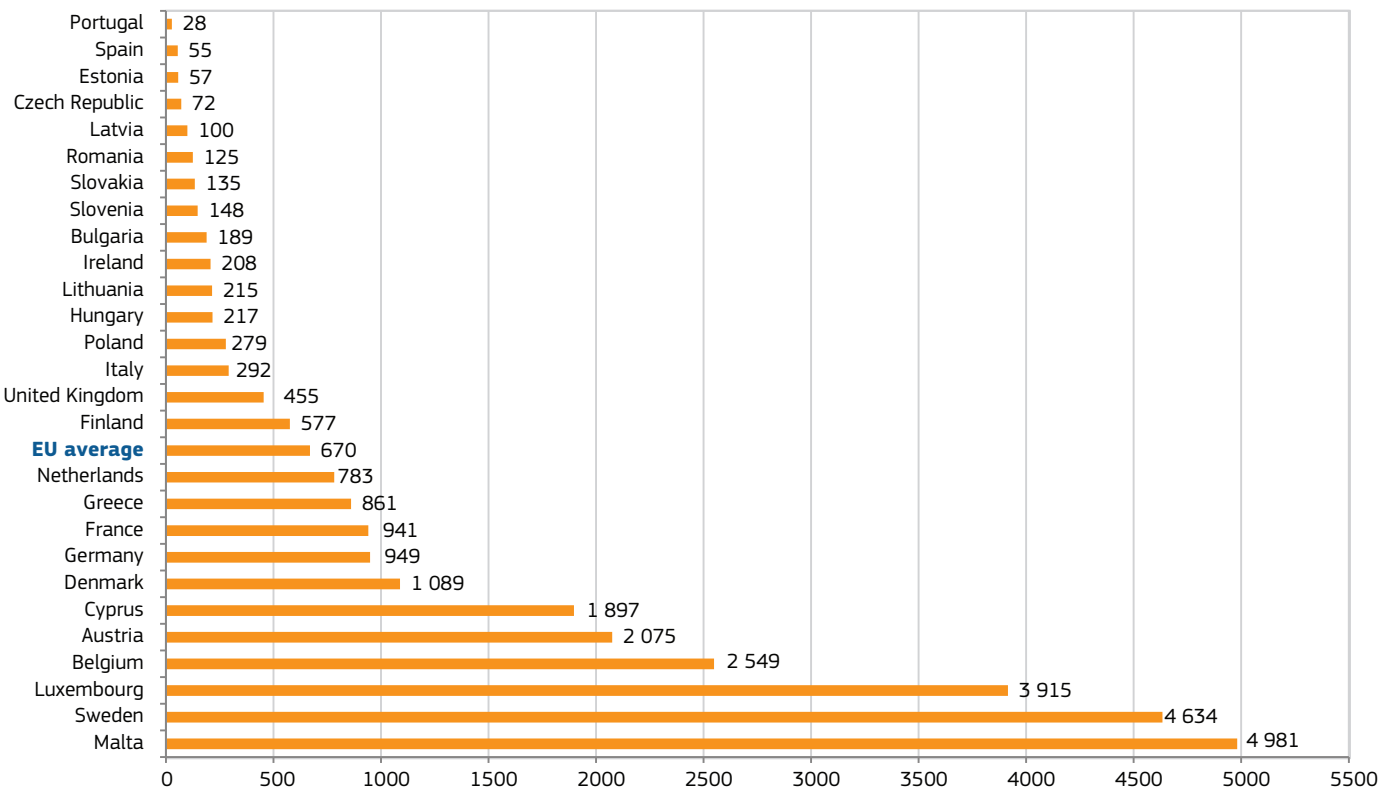

Number of asylum applications in EU27

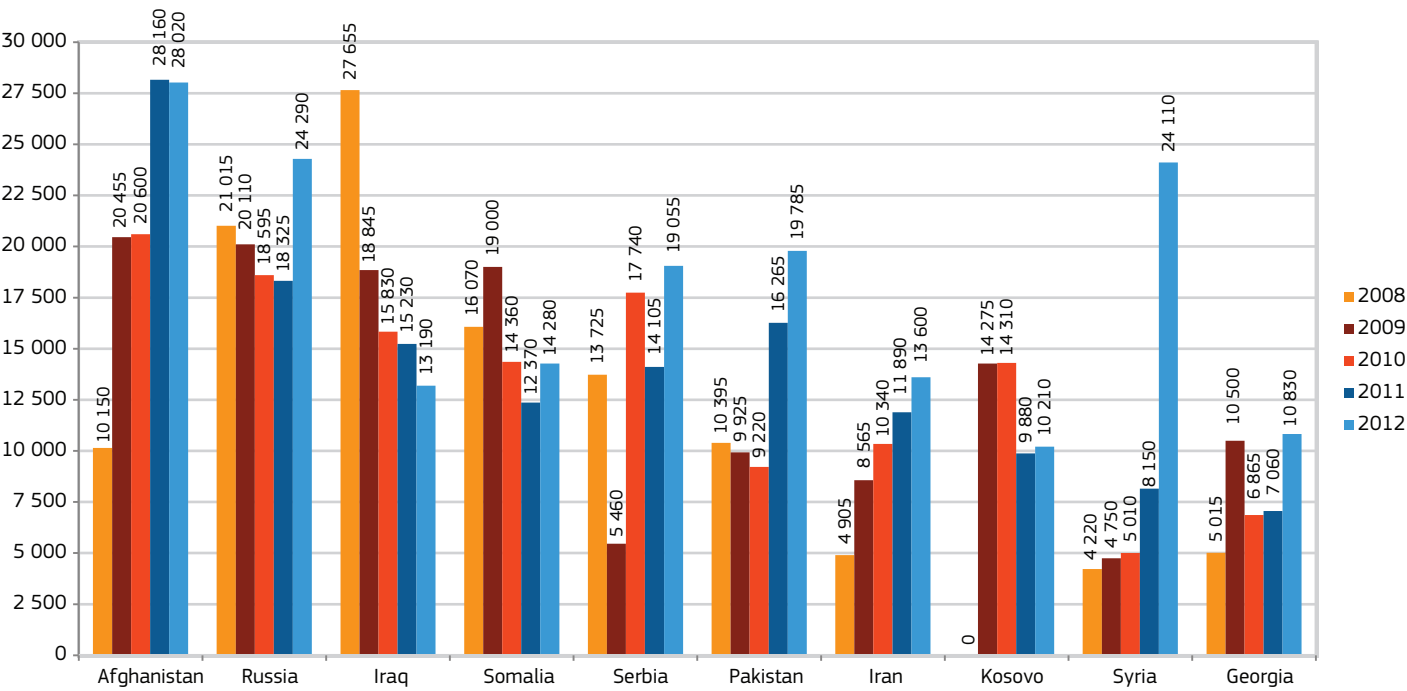


Number of asylum applications per 1 million inhabitants (2012)

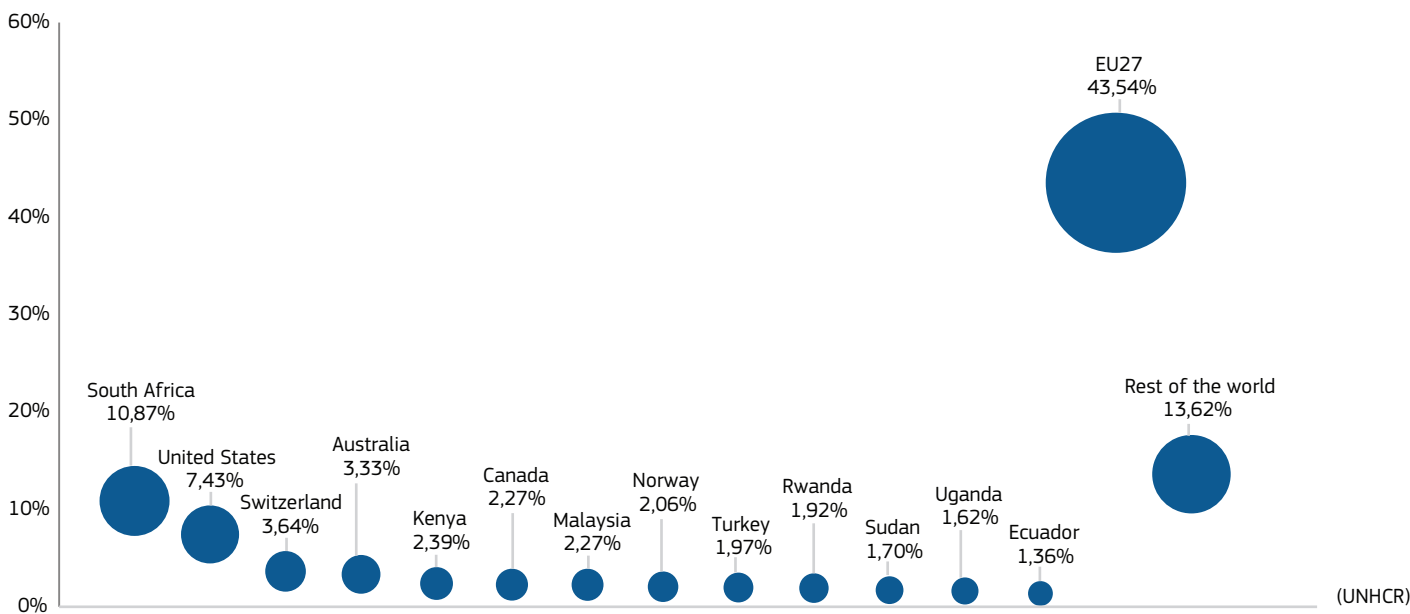

Trend for top 10 countries of origin of asylum seekers

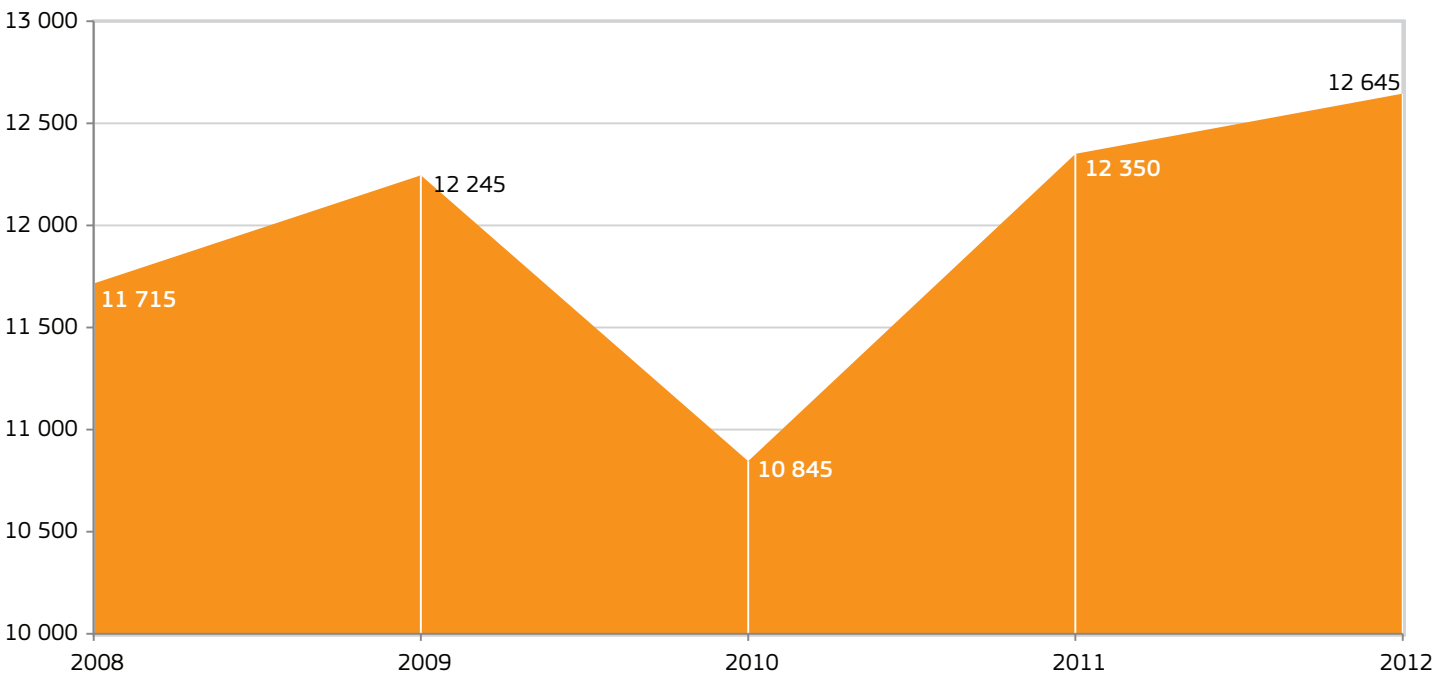


Asylum applications in the world (2012)

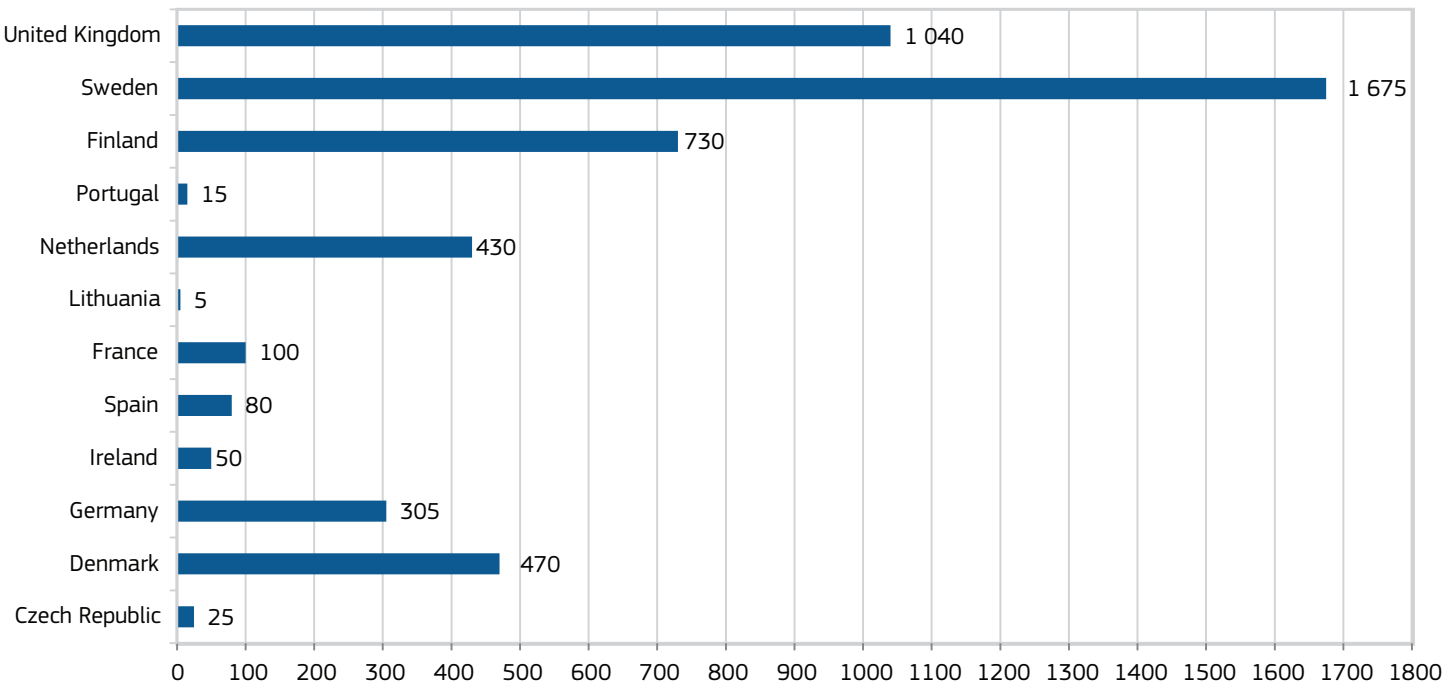

Unaccompanied minors seeking asylum in EU27

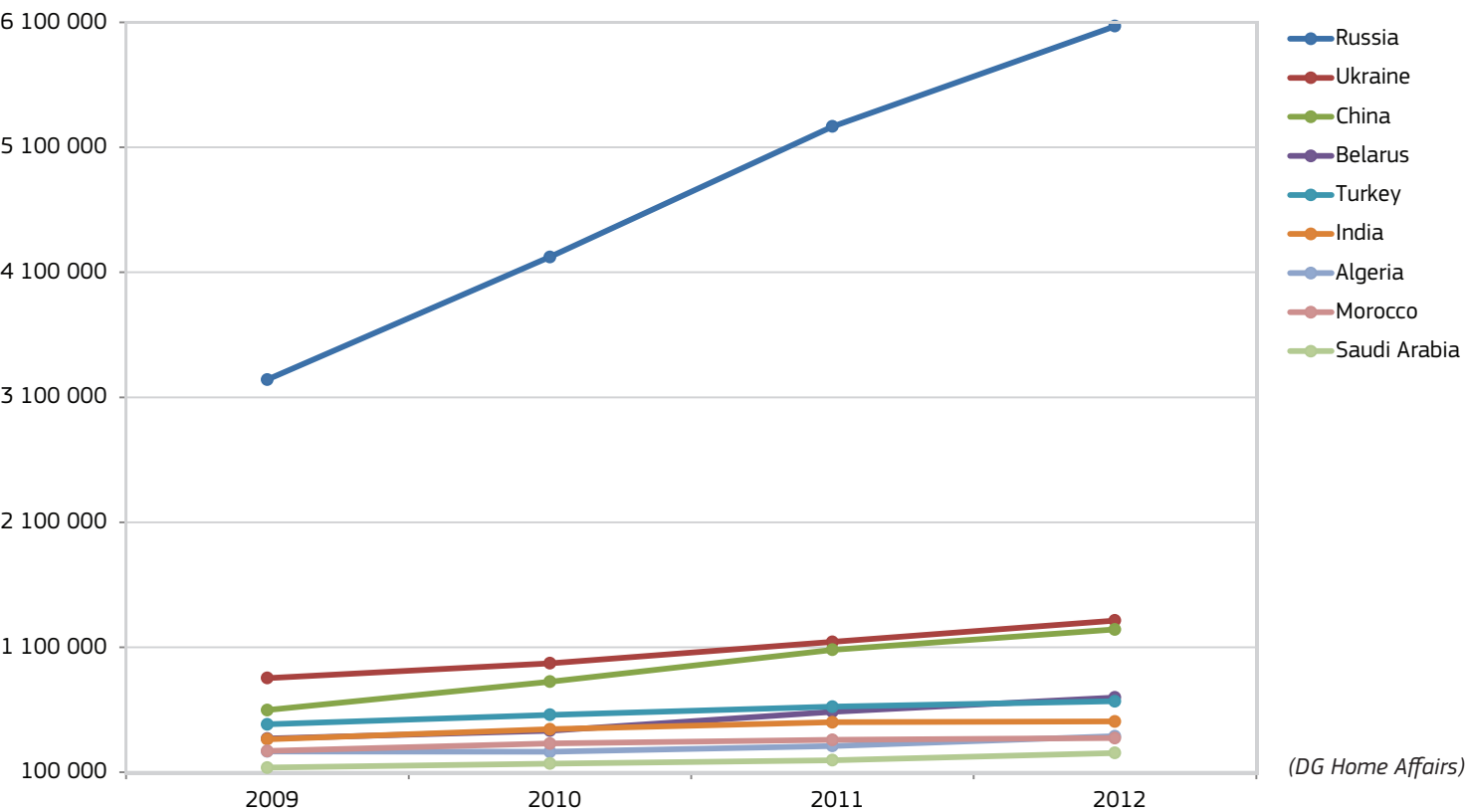


Resettlement in the EU (2012)



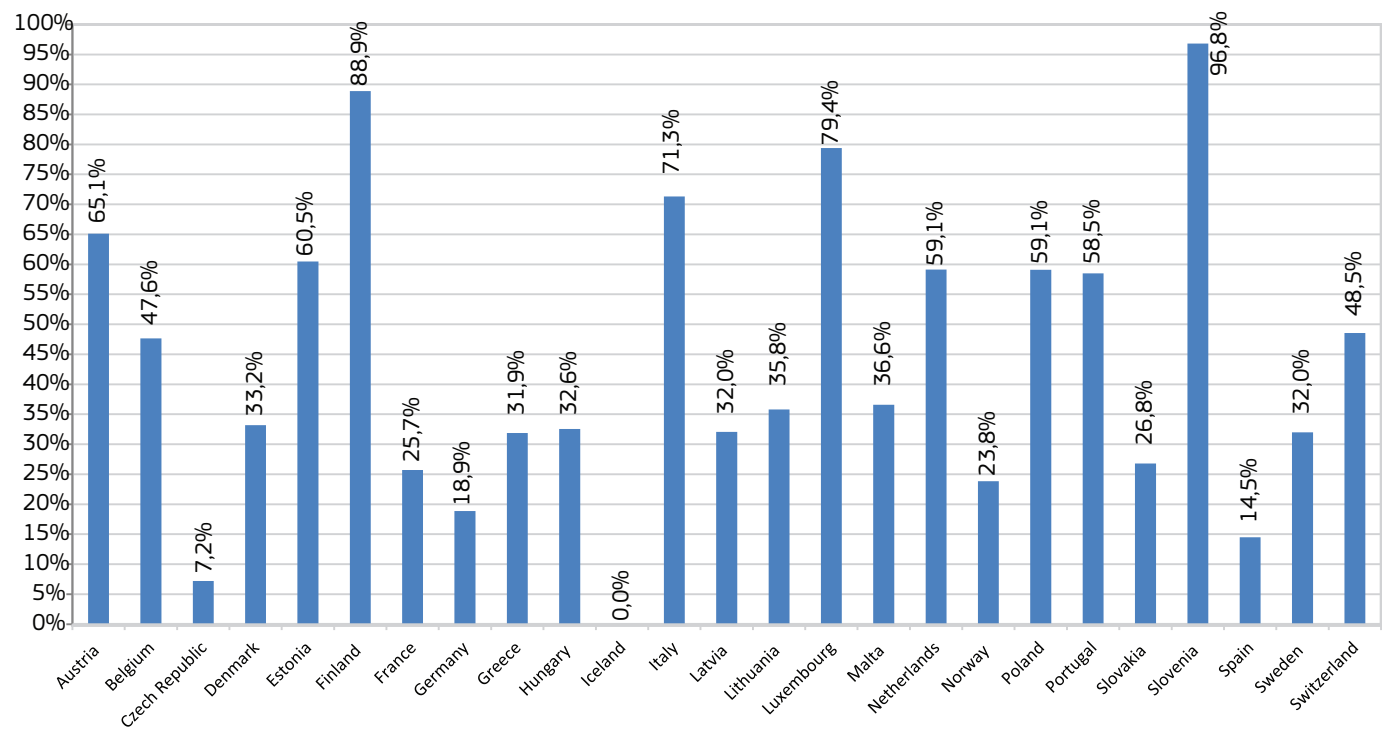

Evolution of number of Schengen visas applied for in main countries



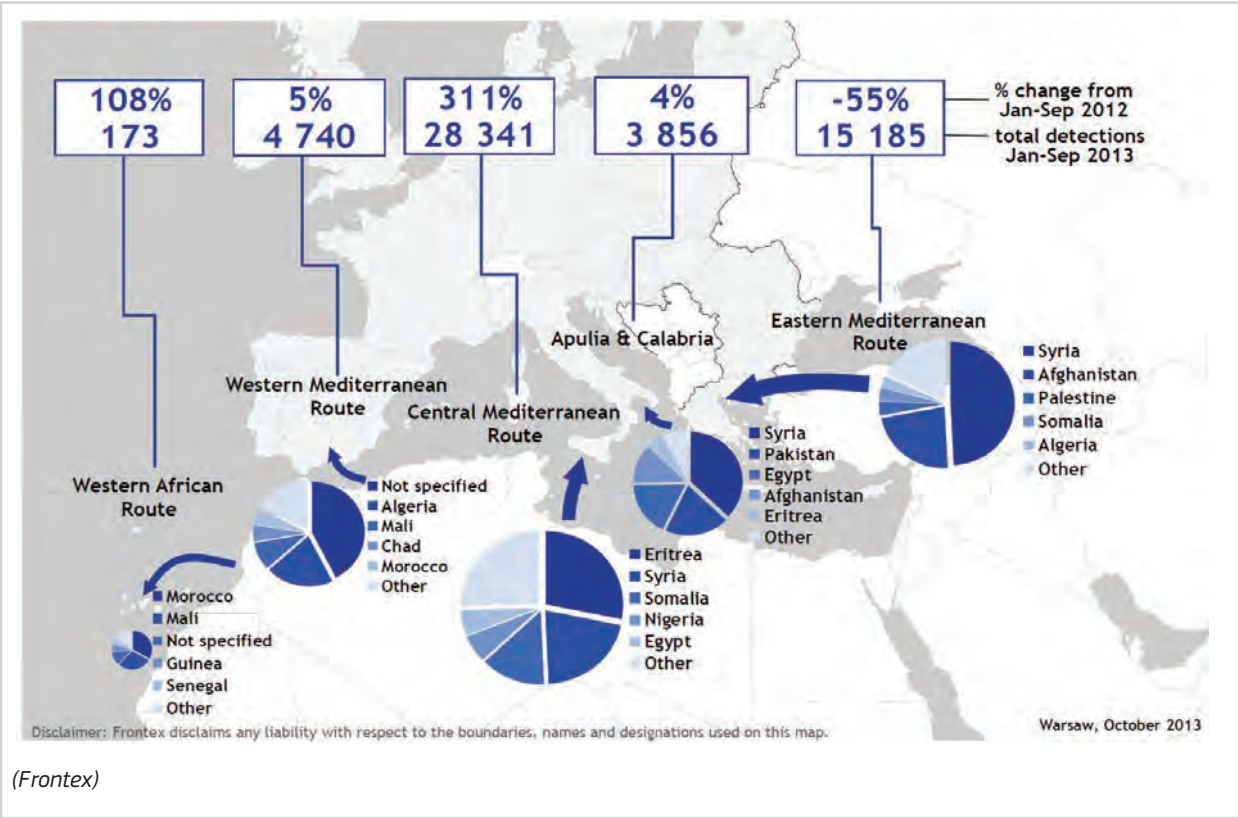
Multiple-entry Schengen visas issued by Schengen States as a percentage of total Schengen visas issued by each State (2012)

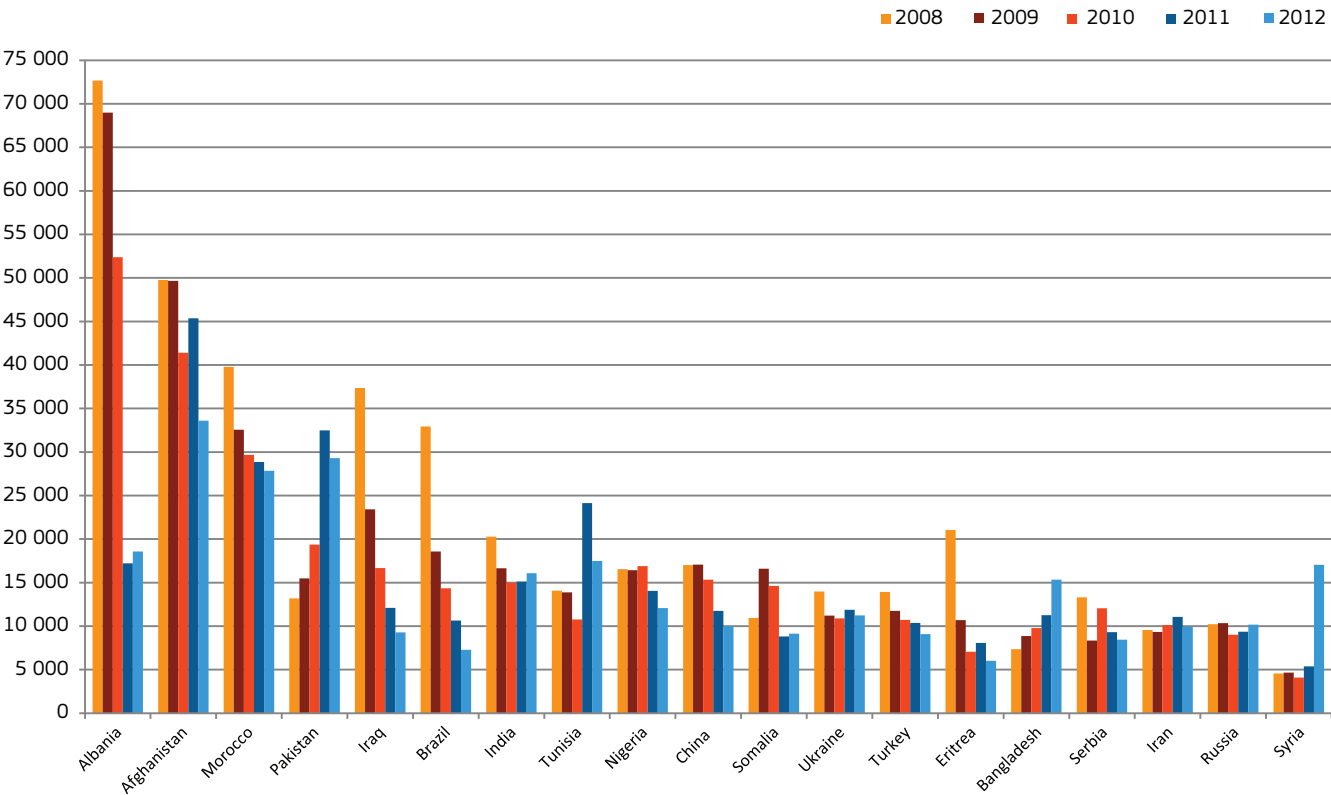

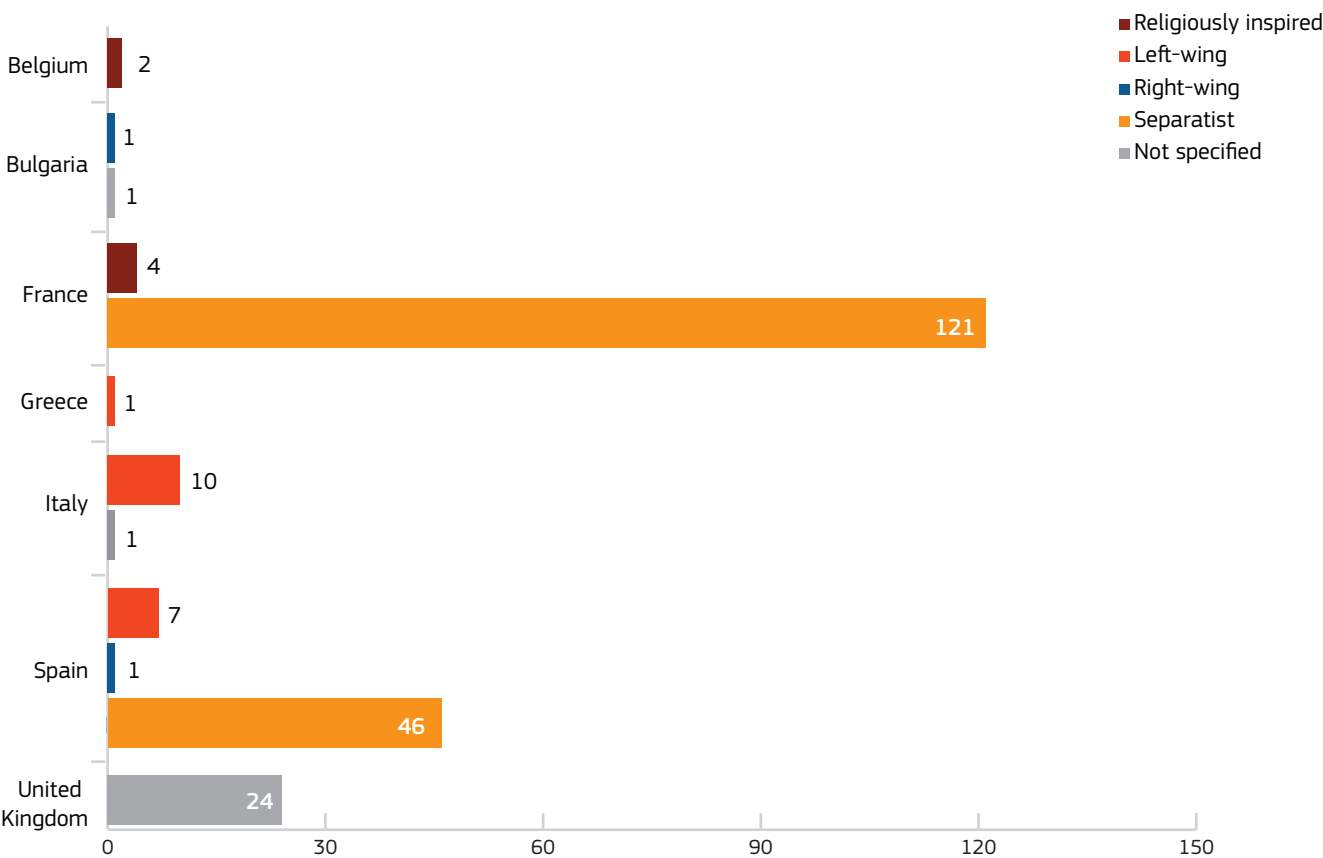
Illegal border crossings: Mediterranean routes Jan-Sept 2013



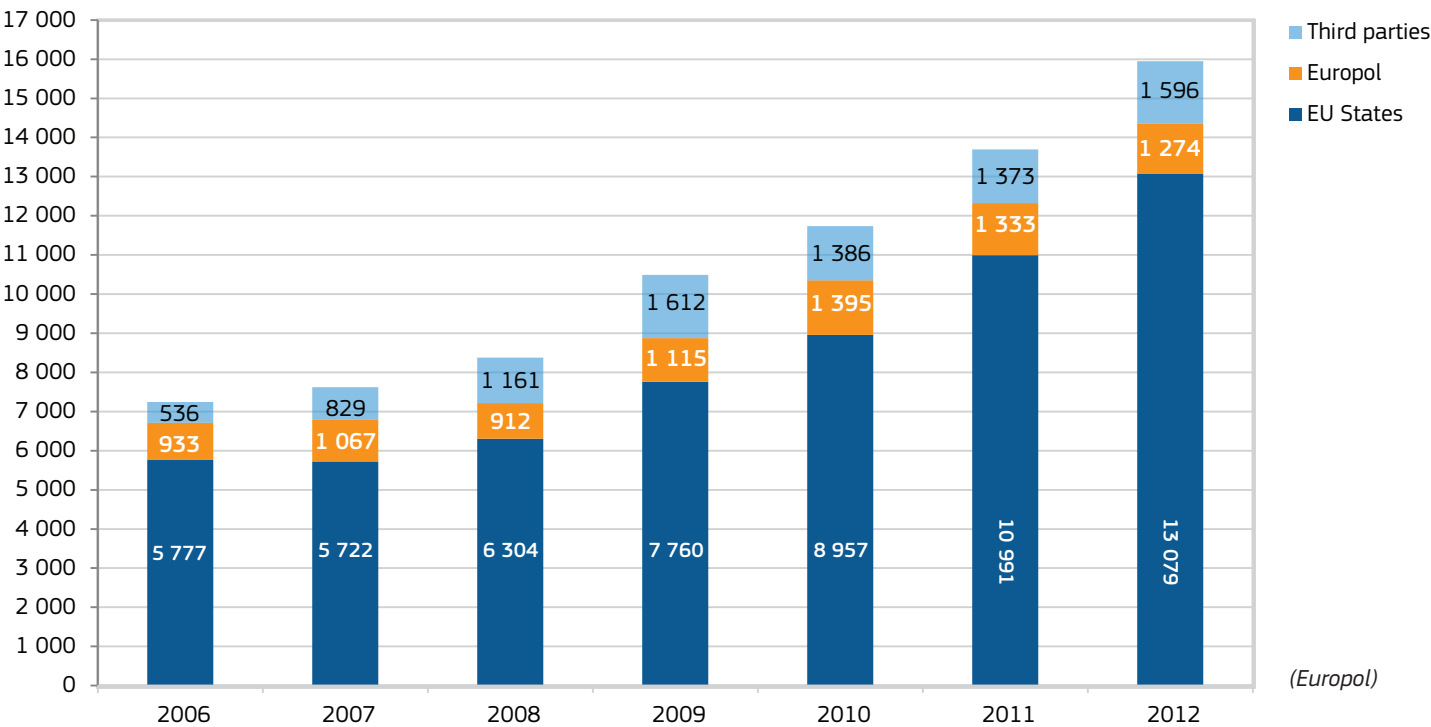
Evolution of apprehensions of irregular migrants by main countries of origin



Overview of failed, foiled and completed terrorist attacks per affiliation (2012)

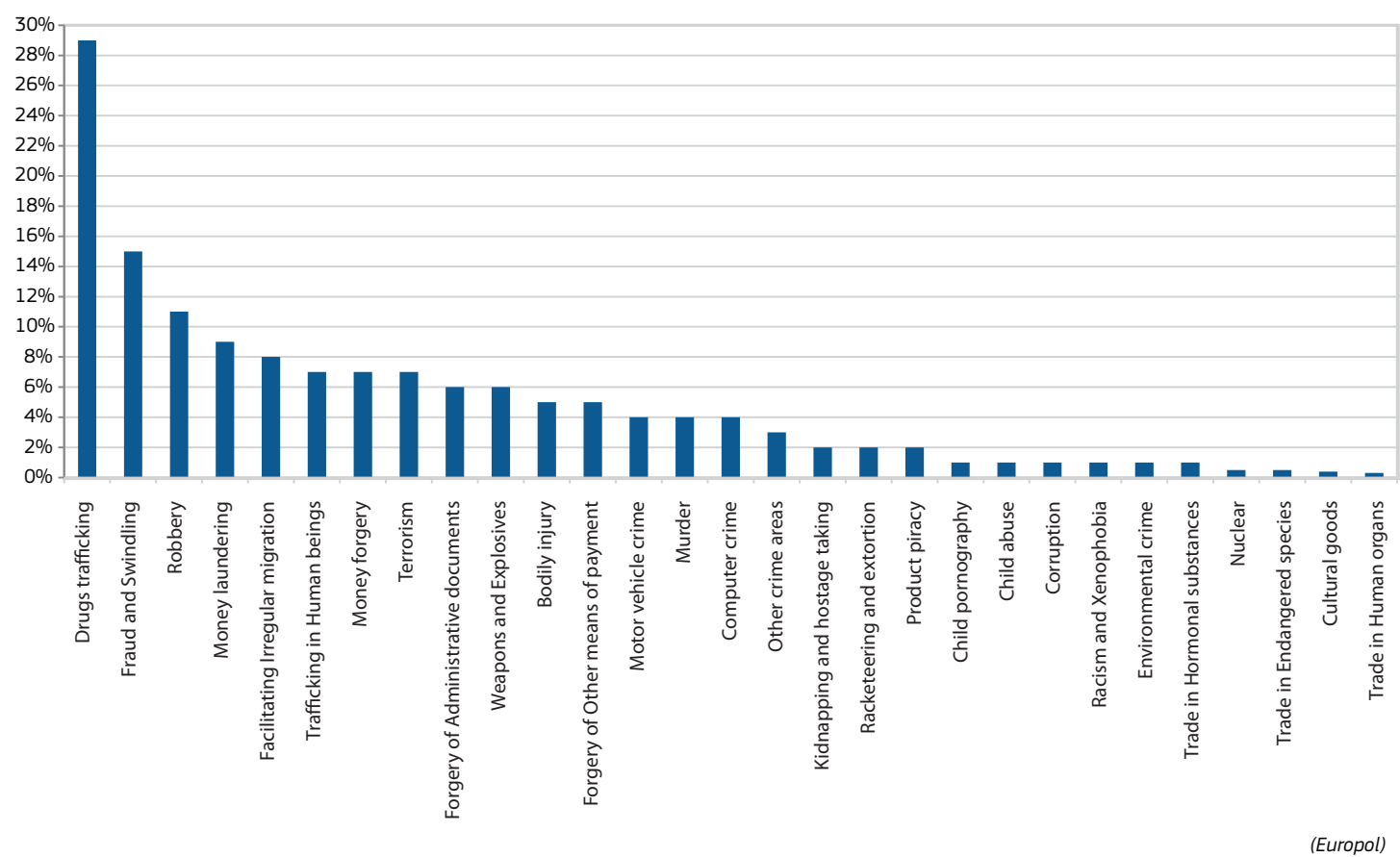


Information exchanged via Europol on crime cases initiated per category of users

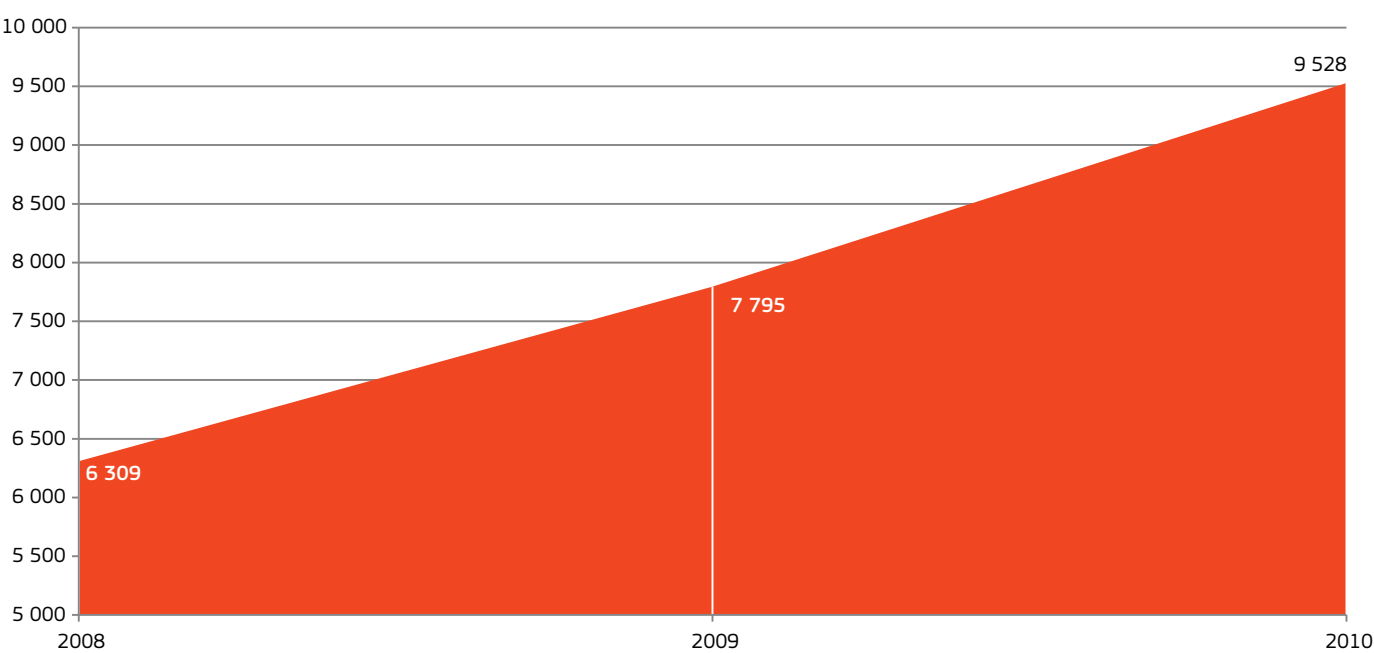

Information exchanged via Europol on cases initiated per crime area (2012)

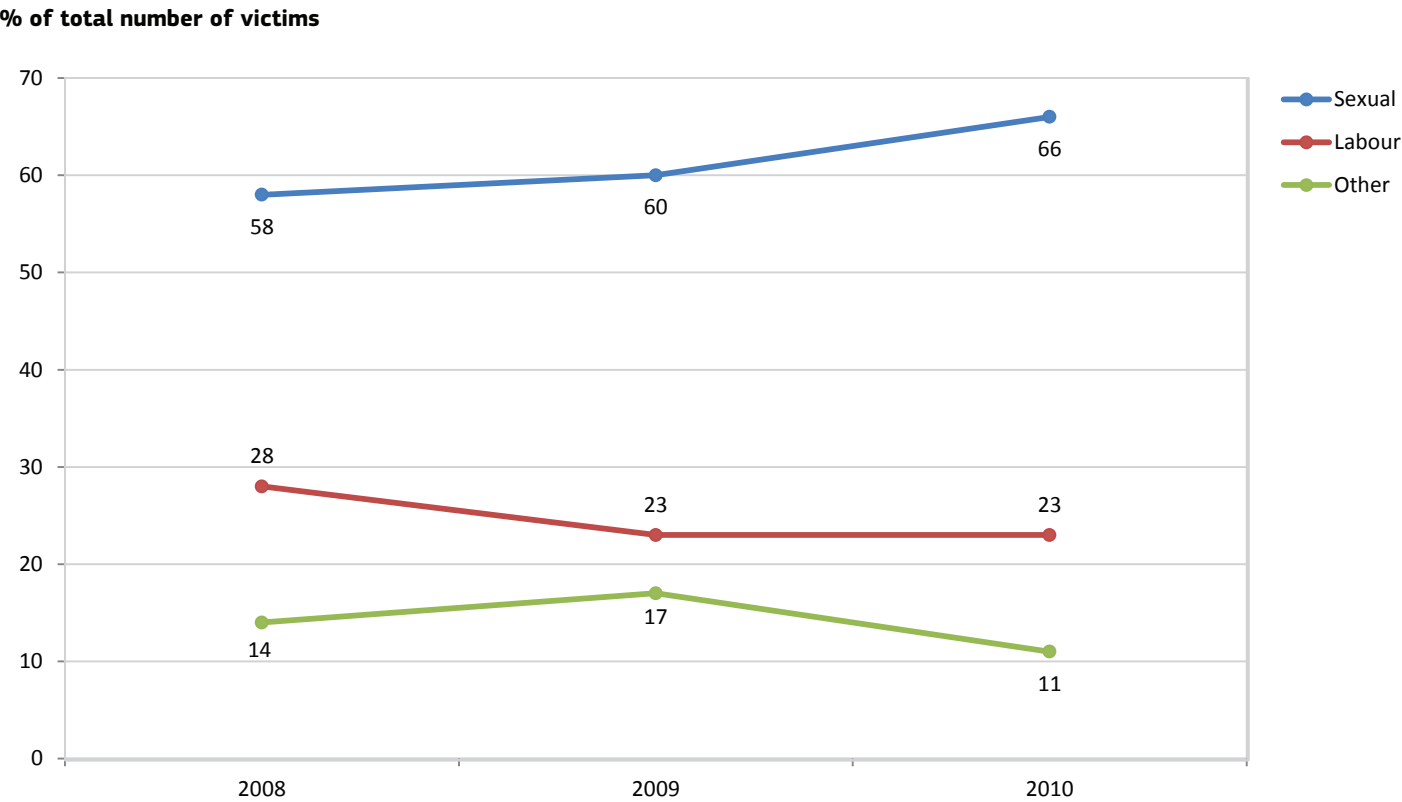


Number of human trafficking victims in countries reporting data for the 3 reference years

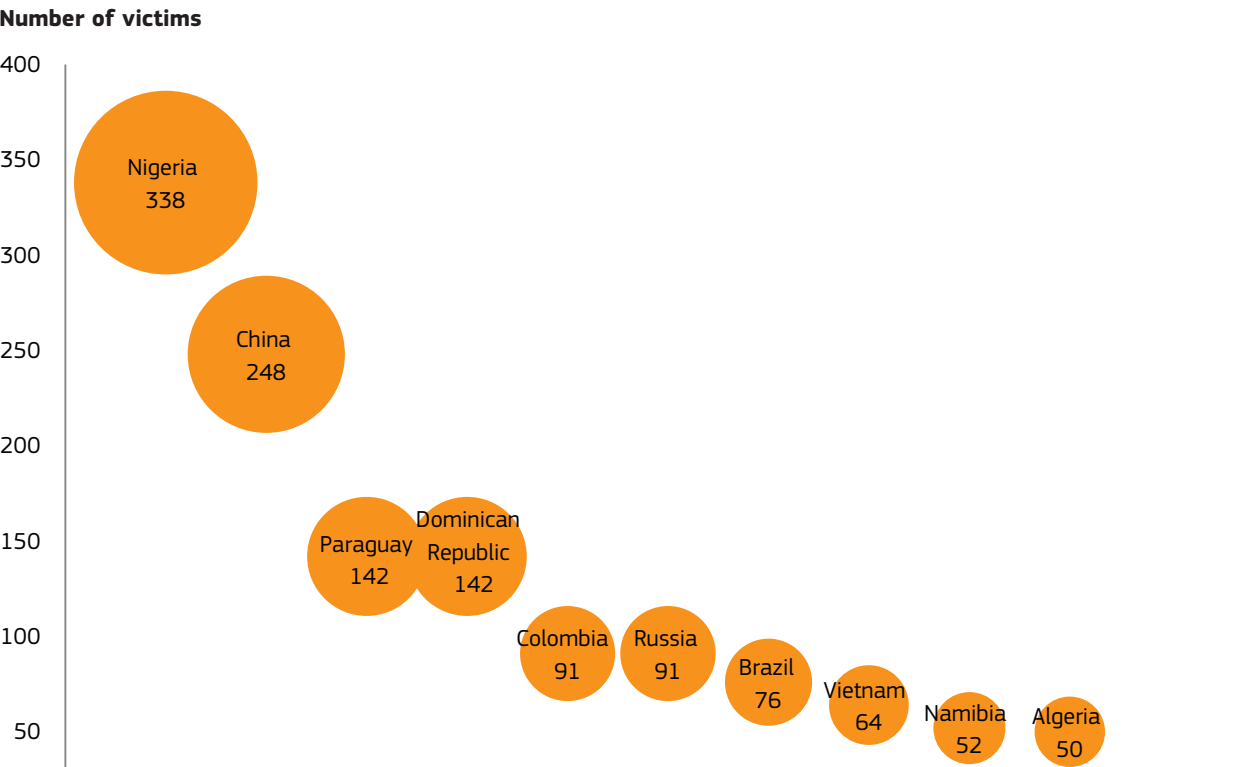
